- Stuffed Animal
- Pillow & Pillow Case (packed back in it's plastic bag)
- Warm, snuggly blanket
- An Encouraging Card/Note From You
- Anything extra you'd like to include a book, school supplies, stickers, coloring/activity book. Think things that don't require outside supplies and that add a little extra love to your bag.

- Children's Book

- Warm, snuggly blanket
- An Encouraging Card/Note From You
- Anything extra you'd like to include Baby Toys, Onesies, PJ's, Socks, Mittens, Pacifiers. Think things that don't require outside supplies and that add a little extra love to your bag.
